# **<u>Title of Position</u>**: Volunteer Docent/Museum Interpreter

**Supervised by:** Sheena Fulkerson (schedules), Jamie Credle (trains)

**<u>Purpose of Job</u>**: To provide a welcoming, hospitable environment and a rewarding learning experience to museum visitors through guided tours.

#### **DUTIES INCLUDE:**

- 1. Conducting museum tours of approximately 30 minutes in length. Be comfortable speaking to small and large groups of people of all ages.
- 2. May be called upon to conduct occasional tours of museum and facilities for VIP's, special visiting groups, etc.
- 3. Greet and welcome tour groups at the beginning of each tour and provide a friendly presents throughout.
- 4. Act as museum security and collections preserver while conducting tours of the museum. Reinforce museum rules to visitors. Report any changes in the museum environment to museum staff.
- 5. Deal skillfully with a diversity of visitors under a variety of circumstances.
- 6. On occasion, assist with special events and programs.
- 7. Inform the supervisor immediately when it becomes apparent that you cannot meet your work responsibilities, i.e. illness.
- 8. Adhere to museum procedures and policies as well as **"Davenport House Museum Expectations."**
